

#### Objectives

"Pom Kuv Hauv Koj (Seeing Me in You") has two principal objectives

- To help teachers to better understand the perspectives of Hmong students and families
- To help teachers to develop an understanding of culturally responsive and culturally sustaining teaching, including arts integration and strategies that support multilingualism



#### To achieve these objectives the program consists of a balance between

- presentations by experts from the Hmong community on history, geography, culture and the experience of Hmong students and families
- hands-on art activities that help participants to synthesize information and learn concrete strategies for arts integration
- modeling of a range of active-learning strategies such as jigsaw reading protocols, gallery walks and object-based learning opportunities to build background knowledge through texts and film





#### 1 Problem of Praxis (Plain Vanilla Philosophical Inquiry Process)

- 2 1) Make a connection between the readings. (Think about a problem in your community working with culturally and linguistically diverse students or the current moment)
- 3 2) Generate ONE question that you would like to talk about today with our group.
- 4 3) Write down the "textual evidence" (quote, page #, reference, or resource) that you used to generate your question,
- 4) Explain the logical reasoning behind why the evidence you cited relates to the question you generated
- 6 5) Once everyone is done, we will vote for our 3 favorite questions (put an x) in the Votes column.
- 7 6) We will discuss the question with the most votes and generate solution(s).
